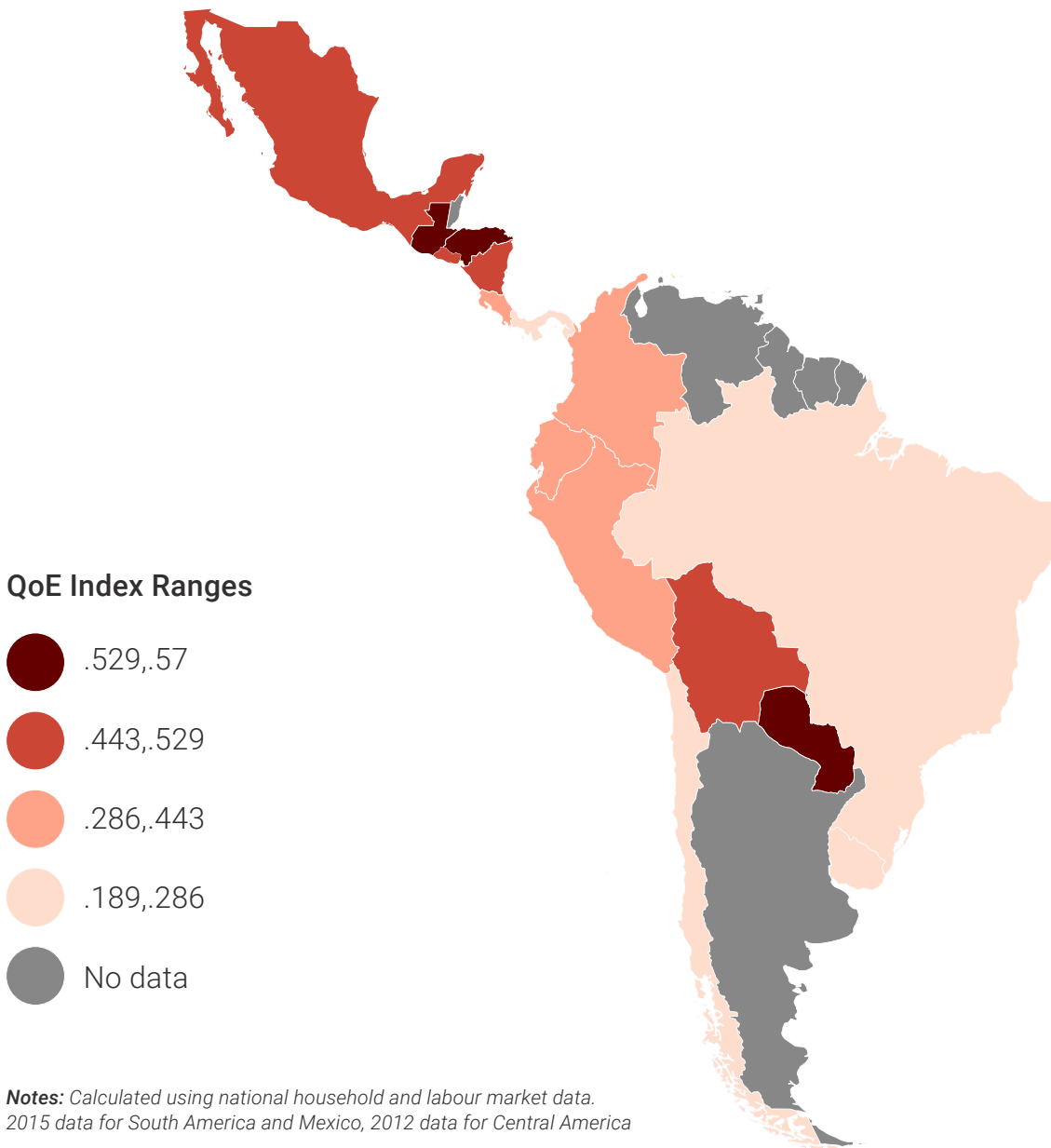


QoE Index: Low Quality of Employment (QoE)

Multidimensional Adjusted Headcount Ratio (M0) - Latin America



This map presents results for the QoE Index. It brings together international data on employment conditions in a single synthetic measure per country. The QoE Index follows Alkire and Foster's methodology for a Multidimensional Adjusted Headcount Ratio (M0), in which we consider the joint distribution of deprivations for the employed individuals in the region. Therefore, this Index combines both the percentage of the deprived and the intensity of the deprivation. The countries with a higher level of deprivation in the region are Guatemala, Honduras and Paraguay (with QoE indices between 0.529 to 0.57). States with the lowest levels of deprivation in the region are Chile, Brazil, Panama and Uruguay (with QoE indices between 0.189 and 0.286). There are significant gaps and variation between labour conditions for working individuals, which could potentially further increase inequalities.
